REQUIREMENTS:

- a doctoral degree (PhD) in Earth and Environmental Sciences,
- research experience in the field of winter river hydrology, including thermal processes and ice phenomena,
- a minimum of 5 scientific publications in journals with an Impact Factor, related to river ice phenomena,
- ability to work with hydrological, climatological, and meteorological data, including their acquisition, processing, and analysis,
- knowledge of environmental and spatial data formats (including netCDF, GeoTIFF),
- proficiency in GIS tools (ArcGIS, QGIS),
- knowledge of statistical methods and time series analysis methods in environmental research,
- programming skills in Python and JavaScript,
- ability to work in the Google Earth Engine environment,
- knowledge of machine learning methods and the ability to apply them in environmental data analysis,
- experience in satellite remote sensing (optical and radar), classification of satellite imagery, and integration of satellite data with ground-based measurements,
- English language proficiency at a minimum level of B2.
