- Documented participation in ongoing or completed scientific projects (experience as PI will be an additional asset)
- Experience in presenting the results of own research at international conferences
- Experience in conducting ecological field research (vegetation, soil, etc.)
- Ability to conduct GIS and statistical analyses: proficiency in GIS software (ArcGIS or QGIS) and statistical software (e.g., R, Statistica, SPSS)
- Very good English language skills in both speech and writing
